Included with such application was Weaver's Cove Environmental Report. Certain pages were "inadvertently" omitted from portions of Resource Report No. 4 to that Environmental Report. The "missing" pages were attached to Attorney Cook's December 23rd letter in a separate envelope labeled: Contains Privileged Information – Do Not Release pursuant to 18 C.F.R. Section 388.112. The proposed LNG location has been designated a Public Involvement Plan (PIP) Site under the Massachusetts Contingency Plan (MCP) 310 CMR 40.0000 for response actions tracked under RTN 4-0749 (1989) for the release of petroleum products and RTN 4-0930 (1990) for the release of gasoline, including lead, petroleum based oil, and waste oil. I am a Petitioner under the referenced PIP and am therefore keenly interested in any future development of the proposed LNG Site that may adversely impact the ongoing environmental remediation of the Site by Shell Oil Company. The proposed LNG terminal Site at 1 New Street in Fall River is bordered in part by the Taunton River, a newly Federally designated Wild &amp; Scenic River. Four primary Federal agencies are charged with protecting and managing our Wild &amp; Scenic River System and our nation's cultural, recreational and natural resources, including the National Park Service. The writer has therefore provided Mr. Dennis R. Reidenbach, Regional Director, Northeast Regional, National Park Service, with numerous environmental documents, letters and reports concerning the extensive environmental contamination at the proposed LNG Site, including copy of a Notice of Responsibility issued by the Department of Environmental Protection to Weaver's Cove Energy, LLC, dated May 18, 2010, concerning a "release and/or threat of release of an unknown quantity of oil, likely to be greater than 10 gallons, and/or hazardous material at the above-referenced property" into the Taunton River. The reason I feel that there is a sense of urgency to this FOIA request is that, according to a recent Email from Mr. Ted Gehrig (Hess LNG) to Mr. David Swearingen (FERC), National Parks Director Jonathan Jarvis reported that in the future his regional staff would be making a second filing with FERC staff. I feel it is imperative, therefore, that the National Park Service be privy to any and all environmental information available in order for Director Jarvis' staff to prepare a complete and comprehensive filing. According to 18 C.F.R. 388.112 (b)(1)(i) Procedures, a person claiming that information is privileged, must file a written statement requesting privileged treatment for some or all of the information in a document, and the justification for nondisclosure of the information. Unfortunately, I see no such "justification" given in Attorney Cook's December 23, 2003, request that the "inadvertently omitted" pages from portions of Resource Report No. 4 now be "treated as privileged and confidential." According to FERC's Guidelines for Filing Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (CEII): (1) The Critical Energy Infrastructure Information (CEII) process is not intended as a mechanism for companies to withhold from public access information that does not pose a risk of attack on the energy infrastructure; and (2) The Commission has continuing concern for CEII filing abuses and will take action against applicants or parties who knowingly misfile information as CEII, including rejection of applications in which information is mislabeled as CEII.
