SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE WAIVING REGULATIONS

(May 8, 2020)

On April 2, 2020, the Secretary of the Commission issued a notice granting, among other things, waiver of the Commission's regulations through May 1, 2020, that govern the form of filings submitted to the Commission to the extent entities are unable to meet those requirements due to the emergency conditions caused by Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19).

Given the ongoing emergency conditions caused by COVID-19, there is good cause to waive through September 1, 2020,¹ the Commission's regulations that require that filings with the Commission be notarized or supported by sworn declarations.²
