ORDER APPROVING UNCONTESTED SETTLEMENT

(Issued June 27, 2005)

1. On April 26, 2005, CMS Generation Michigan Power, L.L.C. (CMS Generation) filed a Settlement Agreement in the above-referenced proceeding. The Settlement Agreement provides for a full and final resolution of all issues related to CMS Generation's rate for Reactive Supply and Voltage Control filed in the above-referenced proceeding.<sup>1</sup> On May 16, 2005, Commission Staff filed comments in support of the Settlement. No other comments and no reply comments were filed. On May 31, 2005, the Settlement Agreement was certified to the Commission as uncontested.
2. The subject Settlement Agreement is in the public interest and is hereby approved. Approval of the Settlement Agreement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e (2000). The Parties agree that the Settlement is subject to the just and reasonable standard of review of sections 205 and 206 of the Federal Power Act.
3. The designations on these tariff sheets are in compliance with Designation of Electric Rate Schedule Sheets, Order No. 614, *FERC Statutes and Regulations, Regulations Preambles July 1996 - December 2000* ¶ 31,096 (2000), and are accepted for filing as designated, to be effective on the date specified in the Settlement.
4. Docket No. ER05-341-000 is terminated.
