ORDER APPROVING UNCONTESTED SETTLEMENT

(Issued November 1, 2006)

1. On July 5, 2006, Chevron Pipe Line Company (Chevron), on behalf of itself, BP Oil Supply Company, ConocoPhillips Company and Valero Marketing and Supply Company filed an offer of settlement in the above-captioned proceedings. The settlement resolves all issues concerning Chevron's Hurricane Recovery Surcharges (HRS) on crude oil barrels transported through Chevron's Empire Terminal in Plaquemines Parish, Louisiana and its Fourchon Terminal in LaFourche Parish, Louisiana.
2. On July 25, 2006, Chevron submitted comments in support of the settlement. No other comments were received. On August 7, 2006, the settlement was certified to the Commission as uncontested.¹
3. The settlement is fair and reasonable and in the public interest and is hereby approved. The settlement resolves all issues raised by Chevron's HRS recovery, and provides shippers with a reporting and true-up mechanism, and a framework for challenging expenses, as well as a refund mechanism.
4. The Commission's approval of this settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding any principle or issue in this proceeding.
5. This order terminates Docket Nos. IS06-231-000, IS06-232-000, IS06-233-000, IS06-251-000, IS06-252-000 and IS06-253-000.
