On March 13, 2007, the North American Energy Standards Board (NAESB) will hold a meeting at the NAESB office in Houston, Texas to discuss NAESB's assistance in the process of developing standards for electronic tariff and rate schedule filings associated with a Commission-managed tariff data base. This effort is in connection with the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking that proposed to require electronic tariff filings. This process will examine the protocols, standards, and data formats applicable to tariffs and tariff filings in order to provide metadata to enable the Commission to develop a tariff database.
