Dear Ms. Weinstein:

1. On May 26, 2006, the Commission issued an order on two Entergy Services, Inc. compliance filings on behalf of several parties, accepting, *inter alia*, EWOM Marketing LP's (EWOM) proposed cost-based rate tariffs for sales by EWOM from the Nelson 6 Generating Unit, the RS Cogen cogeneration facility and the Warren Power generation facility with a term of less than one year, effective subject to refund and conditions, and setting EWOM's proposed cost-based rate tariffs for hearing and settlement judge procedures.¹

2. On February 7, 2007, EWOM filed a Settlement Agreement resolving all issues with respect to EWOM's proposed cost-based rate tariffs that were set for hearing in the above-referenced proceedings. On February 27, 2007, the Commission's Trial Staff

submitted comments in support of the settlement. No other comments were received. On March 21, 2007, the Settlement Judge certified the settlement to the Commission as uncontested.²

3. The tariff designations submitted as part of the settlement do not comply with the *Designation of Electric Rate Schedule Sheets*, Order No. 614 (FERC Stats. & Regs., ¶ 31,096 (2000)). EWOM is required to file rate schedule sheets in conformance with Order No. 614 within 30 days of this order approving the settlement.

4. The subject settlement is fair and reasonable and in the public interest and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of the settlement does not constitute acceptance of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in these proceedings. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e (2000).

5. This order terminates Docket Nos. ER91-569-030, ER01-666-006, ER01-1675-004, ER01-1804-005, ER02-862-006, EL04-123-004 and EL05-105-002. New subdockets will be assigned upon the filing of the required compliance filing.
