Dear Ms. Devers:

1. On January 30, 2009, East Tennessee Natural Gas, LLC (East Tennessee) filed the referenced tariff sheets to revise existing provisions for Enhanced Segmentation on its system. The proposed revisions (1) expand the definition of a segmentable point to include any interconnection with another pipeline or storage facility (Sheet No. 306); and (2) clarify the metering requirements for segmenting by nomination to a segmentable OBA, as well as the required timing and effectiveness of a meter operator's election to remove a meter from a segmentable OBA (Sheet No. 373). East Tennessee requests an April 1, 2009 effective date to allow for related modifications in its electronic customer interface, the Link system. East Tennessee also states that in compliance with a Commission order in Docket Nos. RP00-469, et al.,<sup>1</sup> it will file a report in May 2009 describing implementation of segmentation on its system during the 12-months ending April 1, 2009, and that such report will include a description of the proposed tariff revisions. The Commission accepts the referenced revised tariff sheets to be effective

April 1, 2009, subject to the outcome of our review of East Tennessee's segmentation report.

2. Public notice of East Tennessee's filing was issued on February 3, 2009. Interventions and protests were due as provided in section 154.210 of the Commission's regulations.<sup>2</sup> There are no protests or adverse comments. Pursuant to Rule 214 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure,<sup>3</sup> all timely motions to intervene and any motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance of this order are granted.
