Dear Ms. Stuntz:

1. On October 23, 2009, under Rule 602 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 385.602 (2009), you filed a Settlement Agreement and Explanatory Statement (collectively, Settlement) on behalf of ITC Great Plains, LLC, the Kansas Corporation Commission, Golden Spread Electric Cooperative, Inc., Arkansas Electric Cooperative Corporation, East Texas Electric Cooperative, Inc., Northeast Texas Electric Cooperative, Inc., Tex-La Electric Cooperative of Texas, Inc., Occidental Permian Ltd., Occidental Power Marketing, LP, Occidental Chemical Corporation, Sunflower Electric Power Corporation, and Mid-Kansas Electric Company, LLC.
2. On November 10, 2009, Commission trial staff filed initial comments in support of the Settlement. No other comments were filed. On November 16, 2009, the settlement judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as uncontested.
3. Under the Settlement, the standard of review for any amendment to the Settlement is the just and reasonable standard. The Settlement states that the Commission's approval of the Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.
4. The Settlement is fair, reasonable and in the public interest and is hereby approved. The Settlement does not resolve the issues raised in requests for rehearing and clarification in Docket No. ER09-548-001.

5. This order terminates Docket No. ER09-548-000.
