Reference: Motion to Advance Filing Deadline for Compliance Reports

Dear Mr. Murphy:

1. On January 11, 2010, you filed on behalf of New York Independent System Operator, Inc. (NYISO) a motion to advance the filing deadline for certain compliance reports, to the extent the reports are still required.
2. NYISO states that, as required by the Commission, it has been filing an annual Installed Capacity Demand Curve report (Demand Curve Report) and winter semi-annual new generation projects report (New Generation Projects Winter Report) on January 15 of each year.¹ NYISO requests that the deadline to submit the Demand Curve Report and New Generation Projects Winter Report be moved from January 15 to December 20, beginning with reports to be submitted after January 15, 2010. NYISO states that its proposal will allow it to include data from two full Capability Periods, thereby allowing

NYISO to issue the report more quickly and eliminate less informative partial Capability Period analyses.

3. Notice of NYISO's filing was published in the *Federal Register*, 75 FR 6197 (2010), with protests and interventions due on or before February 1, 2010. No interventions, protests, or comments were filed.

4. The Commission grants NYISO's motion to advance the filing deadline for all future Demand Curve Reports and New Generation Projects Winter Reports to December 20 of each year. Changing the deadline for the reports will allow NYISO to provide the Commission and other interested parties with more detailed and useful information, and is thus reasonable. Further, as the reports provide the Commission and stakeholders with valuable information, NYISO is directed to continue filing the Demand Curve and New Generation Projects Reports until it is otherwise directed by the Commission.
