Reference: Waiver Request of Filing Requirements

Ladies and Gentlemen:

1. On March 17, 2010, Texas Gas Transmission, LLC (Texas Gas) filed a motion for waiver of Ordering Paragraph (F) of the Commission's February 29, 2008,<sup>1</sup> order which required Texas Gas to file a statement on final construction costs within six months after the authorized facilities have been placed into service.<sup>2</sup> The February 29 Order authorized Texas Gas to, among other things, provide storage service through expanded facilities at market-based rates under section 4(f) of the Natural Gas Act (NGA). The February 29 Order also granted waiver of exhibits required for an application under section 7(c) of the NGA when an applicant proposes cost-based rates. Ordering Paragraph (F) of the February 29 Order, required Texas Gas to comply with section 157.20(c)(3) of the Commission's regulations

2. In light of the Commission's approval of market-based rates for Texas Gas' storage services and our previous waiver of certain exhibits required for cost-based rates, the cost-related information required by Ordering Paragraph (F) is not relevant. The

Commission will grant Texas Gas' request for waiver of 18 C.F.R. § 157.20(c)(3) in the February 29 Order, effective April 1, 2010. Texas Gas is required to fully comply with all other provisions in the February 29 Order.
