ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME

(Issued July 12, 2011)

1. On May 13, 2011, the Commission issued an order that among other things, accepted and ordered modifications to an open access transmission tariff (OATT) submitted by Terra-Gen Dixie Valley, LLC (Terra-Gen).¹ On June 13, 2011, Terra-Gen submitted a request for clarification and rehearing of the May 13 Order and Green Borders Geothermal, LLC (Green Borders) submitted a request for clarification, or in the alternative, rehearing of the May 13 Order. As part of its request for rehearing, Terra-Gen included a motion in which it requests that the Commission waive or stay until after the Commission acts on Terra-Gen's rehearing request the requirement in section 2.1 of Terra-Gen's OATT, which provides that applications for new firm transmission service received during the initial sixty day period commencing with the effective date of the OATT will be deemed to have been filed simultaneously, and that a lottery system shall be used to assign priorities for completed applications filed simultaneously. On July 1, 2011, Green Borders submitted a motion for leave to answer and answer in support of Terra-Gen's request for waiver or stay of section 2.1 of Terra-Gen's OATT.

2. Upon consideration, we will grant an extension of time to comply with section 2.1 of Terra-Gen's OATT accepted by the Commission in the May 13 Order until 60 days after the Commission issues an order on the requests for clarification and rehearing of the May 13 Order.
