Dear Counsel:

1. On May 7, 2012, MPS Merchant Services, Inc. and the City of Tacoma, Washington filed an Offer of Settlement, including a Settlement and Release of Claims Agreement (Settlement), which would resolve all issues between them in the referenced proceeding.
2. Initial Comments on the Settlement were filed by Commission Trial Staff on May 29, 2012, and no Reply Comments were filed. On June 12, 2012, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as uncontested.¹
3. The Commission finds that the Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and it is hereby approved.
