



Passive




When we communicate



- Day ahead
- Real-time


What we communicate



- Forecasts, burn rate estimates
- Changes, unscheduled outages, real-time dispatch

During stressed operations...

Pre-established channels are most effective



- Forecast changes, system impacts, outage changes, Alerts, OFOs, pressure reductions, dispatch changes, options
- Curtailment “watch”, required re-dispatch, other changes, Restricted Maintenance Operations, Warnings, curtailments, Emergencies
