Reference: Revisions to Discount Provisions

Dear Mr. Grygar:

1. On March 16, 2004, Trunkline Gas Company, LLC (Trunkline), filed revised tariff sheets¹ to modify the discounting provisions set forth in Rate Schedules FT, SST, EFT, QNT, LFT, FFZ, IT, QNIT, NNS-1, NNS-2, FSS, ISS, GPS, and DVS. Specifically, Trunkline incorporates into each rate schedule language specifying that Trunkline may offer discounted rates based on published index price point differentials or arrived at by formula. Trunkline specifies that any service agreement entered into for an index price-based discount must identify the rate component being discounted. Trunkline also incorporates language stating that, to the extent it discounts the firm reservation charge, it must calculate the index price differential rate formula to state a rate per unit of Maximum Daily Quantity, or associated quantity designation. Trunkline requests an April 15, 2004, effective date for its tariff sheets.

2. The Commission noticed Trunkline's filing on March 19, 2004, permitting comments, protests, or interventions as provided in Section 154.210 of the Commission's regulations. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214) all timely filed motions to intervene and any motions to intervene out-of-time filed before the date this order issues are granted. No party protests or opposes Trunkline's filing.

3. Trunkline's revised tariff sheets are consistent with the Commission's policy on published index price-based discounts. Accordingly, we waive the 30-day notice period and accept the tariff sheets effective April 15, 2004, as proposed. This acceptance benefits the public by promoting transportation and storage service flexibility for Trunkline's customers and stimulating competition in the marketplace.
