NOTICE OF TECHNICAL CONFERENCE

(April 12, 2004)

On January 30, 2004, Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company (Tennessee) filed a request pursuant to sections 157.205, 157.208 and 157.211 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (Commission) regulations under the Natural Gas Act (NGA), for authorization to construct a lateral pipeline and delivery point to facilitate gas transportation services to a new delivery point in Massachusetts under Tennessee's blanket certificate issued in Docket No. CP82-413-000. Commission staff protested the application, objecting to Tennessee's rate proposal. The purpose of the conference is to discuss the Commission staff's protest, the nature of Tennessee's proposal and the underlying business transaction.
