NOTICE CANCELLING TECHNICAL CONFERENCE

(January 24, 2005)

On January 21, 2005, Enbridge Pipelines (KPC) (Enbridge KPC) filed a motion requesting that the Commission postpone the technical conference currently scheduled for January 26, 2005, in the above-docketed proceedings. The technical conference resulted from the Commission's December 22, 2004 order in this proceeding directing the Commission staff to convene a technical conference to focus on the negative deferral fuel account balance and surplus gas on Enbridge KPC. 109 FERC ¶ 61,346 (2004).

The motion states that since the December 22 Order, Enbridge KPC has been diligently preparing for the January 26 technical conference, but that more time is needed due to the unavailability of a key Enbridge KPC employee because of illness. The motion also states that Enbridge KPC believes that such a postponement will allow it to assess more fully the available options for assembling and analyzing the relevant material under the circumstances, and to determine a feasible new date for the technical conference. The motion further states that Enbridge KPC is authorized to report that none of the Commission Staff, the Kansas Corporation Commission, nor the Kansas Gas Service oppose the motion.

Upon consideration, the January 26, 2005 technical conference is cancelled. On or before February 9, 2005, Enbridge KPC will file a supplemental motion proposing a new date for the technical conference.
