ORDER APPROVING UNCONTESTED SETTLEMENT

(Issued January 19, 2006)

1. On December 7, 2005, the City of Anaheim, California (Anaheim) and the California Independent System Operator Corporation (CAISO) filed a settlement agreement, which resolves all issues in the above-captioned proceeding. The settlement agreement resolves all issues relating to Anaheim's revised transmission revenue requirement for the purpose of participation by Anaheim in the CAISO as a Participating Transmission Owner. On December 13, 2005, the Chief Judge granted a Motion for Shortened Comment Period and Expedited Approval. On December 14, 2005, the Commission's Trial Staff filed comments in support of the settlement agreement. No other comments were filed. On December 20, 2005, the settlement judge certified the settlement agreement to the Commission as uncontested.
2. The settlement agreement is in the public interest and is hereby approved. The rate schedule sheets submitted as part of the settlement agreement are in compliance with Order 614. *See Designation of Electric Rate Schedule Sheets*, Order No. 614, 65 Fed. Reg. 18,221, (FERC Statutes & Regulations, Regulations Preambles July 1996-December 2000 ¶ 31,096 (2000)). The rate schedules are hereby accepted for filing and made effective as specified in the settlement agreement. Refunds shall be made pursuant to the settlement agreement.
3. The Commission's approval of this settlement agreement does not constitute approval of or precedent regarding any principle or issue in this proceeding.
4. This order terminates Docket No. EL05-131-000.
