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Dear Sirs:

1. The Commission has reviewed the requests of all parties to these proceedings that they be required to file additional status reports, covering the first quarter of 2006, describing the effectiveness of the Protocol, filed by the parties on February 18, 2005, in

implementing Public Service Electric & Gas Company (PSE&G)'s contractual obligation to wheel power for Consolidated Edison Company of New York (ConEd).¹ Upon consideration, the Commission finds that status reports covering the three-month period January through March 2006, would provide additional information concerning the parties' performance under the Protocol and whether revisions to the Protocol are needed. The Commission therefore requires the parties to submit these reports within 30 days of the issue date of this order.

2. This action is without prejudice as to any order or findings that have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in these or other proceedings.
