ORDER APPROVING UNCONTESTED SETTLEMENT

(Issued July 20, 2005)

1. On March 1, 2004, Williams Power Company, Inc. (Williams),<sup>1</sup> the California Independent System Operator (CAISO), and AES Southland LLC filed a settlement agreement concerning changes to the rates and terms of Williams' Reliability Must-Run Agreements with the CAISO, which effectively resolves all of the issues in the above-referenced docket.
2. The subject settlement is in the public interest and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of this settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms, and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e (2000).
3. This order terminates Docket No. ER03-132-000.
