- RTA efforts in early 90s – EPACT 92
- Colorado Coordinated Planning Group (CCPG)
- Central Arizona Transmission Study (CATS)
- Southwest Area Transmission Study Group (SWAT)

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WestConnect Planning Participation Agreement

- Effective May 23, 2007 with all WestConnect Members on board
- Open for execution by any other party that participates in a subregional planning group
- Provides funding for the independent facilitation of the subregional planning processes
- Enhances openness and transparency

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Order 890 Principles

- WestConnect Strawman is posted – addresses all 9 principles
- Cost Allocation
