NOTICE OF TECHNICAL CONFERENCE

(November 6, 2007)

Take notice that the Commission will convene a technical conference in the above-referenced proceeding on Thursday, November 15, 2007, at 2:00 pm (EDT), in a room to be designated at the offices of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission, 888 First Street, NE, Washington, DC 20426.

The Commission's October 31, 2007 Order¹ directed that a technical conference be held to address the issues raised by Wyoming Interstate Company's (WIC) September 19, 2007, tariff filing to revise its fuel tracking mechanism.

Commission Staff and parties will have the opportunity to discuss all of the issues raised by WIC's proposal to modify its fuel and LUF mechanism. Specifically, WIC should be prepared to address all the concerns raised in the protests, and if necessary, to provide additional technical, engineering and operational support for its proposals. Any party proposing alternatives to WIC's proposals should also be prepared to similarly support its position.
