Reference: Motion to Dismiss Complaint

Dear Ms. Schindler:

1. On June 11, 2008 Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation (Columbia) filed a motion to dismiss the above captioned complaint filed on June 6, 2008 by eleven shippers

on the Columbia system. Columbia asserts that the issues raised by the complaint can be addressed in the context of a Natural Gas Act (NGA) section 4 tariff filing it made on June 5, 2008 in Docket No. RP08-401-000 and, therefore, the complaint should be dismissed immediately without the need for Columbia to file an answer to the complaint.

2. The Commission denies Columbia's motion to dismiss. Answers to the complaint must be filed on or before June 20, 2008, consistent with the procedural schedule established in the June 9, 2008 notice of the complaint.
