Dear Mr. Johnson:

1. On December 1, 2006, Southern Star Central Gas Pipeline, Inc. (Southern Star) filed Sixth Revised Sheet No. 12 to its FERC Gas Tariff, Original Volume No. 1 and supporting workpapers to reflect annual adjustments to its fuel and loss reimbursement percentages (FLRPs) as required by section 13 of its tariff's General Terms and Conditions (GT&C). Subsequently, the Missouri Public Service Commission (MoPSC) and the Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) filed protests and requests for a technical conference to discuss the issues raised by Southern Star's filing. On December 29, 2006, the Commission issued an order¹ accepting and suspending the tariff sheet, to become effective January 1, 2007, subject to refund and to a technical conference established to address the issues raised by the filing.

2. The technical conference was held on February 2, 2007. Following the technical conference and based on comments made therein, both MoPSC and KCC filed additional comments withdrawing their original objections. Southern Star's filing appears to be just

and reasonable and has not been shown to be unjust, unreasonable, unduly discriminatory or preferential or otherwise unlawful. Accordingly, the Commission now lifts the suspension on the abovementioned tariff sheet and closes the proceedings in this docket. The abovementioned revised tariff sheet is accepted, effective January 1, 2007.
