ORDER APPROVING UNCONTESTED SETTLEMENT

(Issued December 23, 2008)

1. Tenaska Alabama II Partners, L.P. (Tenaska Alabama II), Tenaska Alabama Partners, L.P. (Tenaska Alabama), and Southern Company Services, Inc., acting as agent for Alabama Power Company (collectively, Southern), filed a Settlement Agreement (Settlement) establishing revised annual revenue requirements for Reactive Supply and Voltage Control from Generation Sources Service for Tenaska Alabama II and Tenaska Alabama. The Settlement resolves all of the issues in the captioned proceedings.
2. The Commission Trial Staff filed comments in support of the Settlement. No other comments were filed. On November 5, 2008, the Presiding Administrative Law Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as uncontested.¹
3. The Settlement is fair and reasonable and in the public interest and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of the Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in these proceedings. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms, and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standards of section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e (2006).
4. The tariff sheets submitted as part of the Settlement are properly designated, accepted for filing, and made effective as specified in the Settlement.²

5. Within 10 business days from the date of this approval, Tenaska Alabama II and Tenaska Alabama shall provide Southern with corrected invoices, as provided in the Settlement. Southern is directed to make payments, consistent with the Settlement, to Tenaska Alabama II and Tenaska Alabama within 20 calendar days from receipt of the corrected invoices.

6. This order terminates Docket Nos. ER07-746-000, ER07-902-000, ER07-746-001, and ER07-902-001.
