Dear Mr. Troxell:

1. On June 1, 2009, Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (Midwest ISO) and MidAmerican Energy Company (MidAmerican) made simultaneous filings under section 205 of the Federal Power Act in connection with MidAmerican's integration into Midwest ISO. One such filing was made in the above-captioned docket to address the classification of MidAmerican's Grandfathered Agreements (GFAs) through appropriate amendments to Attachment P (List of Grandfathered Agreements) of Midwest ISO's Open Access Transmission, Energy and Operating Reserve Markets Tariff (Tariff).
2. On July 16, 2009, the Commission issued an order<sup>1</sup> conditionally accepting Midwest ISO's Attachment P revisions, subject to a compliance filing making the

corrections Midwest ISO agreed to make in response to the comments submitted by MidAmerican, Basin Electric Power Cooperation and Associated Electric Cooperative, Inc.

3. On August 17, 2009, in compliance with the July 16 Order, Midwest ISO submitted for filing revisions to Attachment P of Midwest ISO's Tariff correcting Attachment P's list of MidAmerican's existing transmission and related agreements.
4. Midwest ISO states that it corrected the identification and classification of MidAmerican's GFAs. In addition, Midwest ISO states that it corrected the GFA numbers assigned to some newly listed GFAs to avoid duplication of earlier GFA numerical designations. Midwest ISO also indicates that it corrected a typographical error on Original Sheet No. 2890G. Finally, Midwest ISO states that it included, for informational purposes, corrections to two previously submitted Tables outlining the proposed changes to Attachment P.
5. Midwest ISO requests an effective date of September 1, 2009, the effective date accepted by the July 16 Order.
6. Notice of the Applicants' filing was published in the *Federal Register*, 74 Fed. Reg. 42,887 (2009), with interventions or protests due on or before September 8, 2009. Comments were filed by Corn Belt Power Cooperative (Corn Belt). Midwest ISO filed an answer to Corn Belt's comments.
7. Corn Belt states that its GFA No. 483 should read as having been amended September 13, 1971, not September 12, 1971. Corn Belt asks that the Attachment P be corrected for GFA No. 483, to reflect this minor correction to the date of the amendment.
8. Midwest ISO states in its answer that it agrees to make the necessary typographical correction as part of a further compliance filing after the Commission acts on the August 17 compliance filing.<sup>2</sup>
9. Rule 213(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 385.213(a)(2) (2009), prohibits an answer to a protest unless otherwise ordered by the decisional authority. We will accept Midwest ISO's answer because it has provided information that assisted us in our decision-making process.
10. We find that Midwest ISO's revised Attachment P complies with the July 16 Order, with one exception. We agree with Corn Belt that GFA No. 483 should be

corrected to reflect the amendment date of September 13, 1971, rather than September 12, 1971, as it is currently listed. Therefore, we direct Midwest ISO to revise Attachment P, in a compliance filing to be submitted within 30 days of the date of this order, to make the correction to the date of the amendment to GFA No. 483.

11. We will therefore accept, subject to the further compliance filing directed above, Midwest ISO's proposed Attachment P revisions, to be effective September 1, 2009, as requested.
