In Order No. 714,¹ the Commission adopted regulations requiring that, starting April 1, 2010, tariff and tariff related filings must be made electronically. As the implementation date approaches, Commission staff will be enhancing the opportunities for developers and industry to address issues and questions about the mechanics of the electronic filing process.
