Reference: Motion to Withdraw Tariff Filing

Ladies and Gentlemen:

1. On January 28, 2010, Wyoming Interstate Company, Ltd. (WIC) filed proposed tariff sheets pursuant to section 4 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA) to revise its gas quality allocation procedures that WIC may implement when carbon dioxide or Btu issues on downstream pipelines cause a downstream pipeline to refuse to accept delivery of gas from WIC. On February 25, 2010, the Commission accepted and suspended the tariff sheets, subject to the outcome of a technical conference.<sup>1</sup> A technical conference was convened on March 24, 2010. On April 14, 2010, following discussion at the technical conference, WIC submitted a motion to withdraw its filing. No party opposes the motion to withdraw. Accordingly, the Commission accepts WIC's motion to withdraw its filing and terminates Docket No. RP10-337-000.
