1. On April 20, 2010, on behalf of T.E.S. Filer City Station Limited Partnership, you filed in the above-referenced docket an Unopposed Offer of Settlement providing for the full and final resolution of all issues related to T.E.S. Filer City Station Limited Partnership's request to implement a revenue requirement for Reactive Supply and Voltage Control from Generation Sources Service. On May 10, 2010, Commission Trial Staff filed comments in support of the settlement. On May 11, 2010, the Settlement Judge certified the settlement to the Commission as uncontested.
