NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF TIME

(March 2, 2011)

On February 24, 2011, the American Public Power Association, the Edison Electric Institute and the National Rural Electric Cooperative Association requested an additional 45 days (until April 21, 2011 for initial comments and May 5, 2011 for reply comments) to respond to the Supplemental Notice Requesting Comments (Supplemental Notice) that was issued by the Commission on February 16, 2011 in this proceeding.<sup>1</sup> On February 25, 2011, the GridWise Alliance made a similar request,<sup>2</sup> and on March 1, 2011, the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California also requested an additional 45 days.<sup>3</sup> Movants state that the additional time is needed to adequately address the issues raised in the Supplemental Notice.

Upon consideration, notice is hereby given that persons wishing to comment on the issues discussed in the Supplemental Notice, or any other topic raised during the January 31, 2011 technical conference in this proceeding, are granted an extension of time to submit comments to the Commission until no later than April 8, 2011. Reply comments should be submitted by April 22, 2011.
