ORDER VACATING SECTION 3 AUTHORIZATION

(Issued August 23, 2011)

1. On June 15, 2006, the Commission issued an order granting, *inter alia*, Creole Trail LNG, L.P. (Creole Trail LNG) the authority under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA) to site, construct, and operate a liquefied natural gas (LNG) terminal in Cameron Parish, Louisiana for the receipt of foreign-source LNG.¹ Ordering Paragraph (D) of the June 15, 2006 Order required the authorized facilities to be completed and placed into service within four years of the date of the order. In a letter order issued on May 19, 2010, the Director of the Division of Pipeline Certificates extended until June 15, 2011 the deadline for constructing and placing the LNG terminal into service.² Since Creole Trail LNG did not construct and place the LNG terminal into service as required by June 15, 2011, this authorization has expired. Thus, this order vacates the authorization issued to Creole Trail LNG in the June 15, 2006 Order.

The Commission orders:

The authorization issued to Creole Trail LNG in the June 15, 2006 Order to site, construct, and operate an LNG terminal under NGA section 3 is vacated.

² The June 15, 2006 Order also authorized Cheniere Creole Trail Pipeline, L.P. in Docket No. CP05-357-000 to construct and operate a 116.8 mile-long, dual 42-inch diameter pipeline. Although the LNG terminal facility was never constructed, portions of the authorized pipeline facilities have been constructed and placed into service.
