NOTICE OF DETERMINATION BY THE CHAIRMAN

Take notice that Jon Wellinghoff, acting as Motions Commissioner, pursuant to Rule 715 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, has determined that the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) and Western Area Power Administration (Western) have failed to demonstrate extraordinary circumstances, in accordance with Rule 715(c)(5) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 385.715(c)(5) (2011), that would make prompt Commission review of the contested ruling necessary to prevent detriment to the public interest or irreparable harm to any person. Accordingly, the Chairman will not refer to the full Commission the August 24, 2011 interlocutory appeal filed by the BPA and Western.
