ORDER VACATING CERTIFICATE, SECTION 3 AUTHORIZATION, AND
PRESIDENTIAL PERMIT

(Issued October 28, 2011)

1. On March 24, 2004, the Commission authorized Calypso U.S. Pipeline, LLC (Calypso) pursuant to section 7 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA) to, among other things, construct and operate natural gas pipeline facilities from the United States/Bahamas Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ) boundary to a point on the Florida coast for the transportation of natural gas.¹ The Commission also issued Calypso a Presidential Permit, pursuant to section 3 of the NGA to site, construct, and operate natural gas facilities at the United States/EEZ boundary for the importation of natural gas. In an order issued January 25, 2007, the authorizations were modified and the deadline for completing construction extended to June 30, 2010.² In a letter order dated June 15, 2010, the Director of the Office of Energy Projects extended the construction deadline to June 30, 2012.

2. On August 15, 2011, Calypso filed a letter with the Commission stating that it was terminating its proposed project and surrendering the authorizations and Presidential

Permit issued in this proceeding. No one has opposed the request and we will vacate the authorizations and the Presidential Permit.

The Commission orders:

The authorization under section 3 of the NGA, the certificate under section 7 of the NGA, and the Presidential Permit issued to Calypso in this proceeding are vacated.
