Dear Mr. Wuslich:

1. On November 14, 2011, you submitted an offer of settlement (Settlement) on behalf of Midland Cogeneration Venture Limited Partnership (MCV) in the above-captioned proceeding. On December 5, 2011, comments, supporting the Settlement and urging certification and ultimate approval were filed by the Commission's Trial Staff. No other comments were filed. On December 19, 2011, the settlement judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as uncontested.

2. The Settlement resolves all issues set for hearing in *Midland Cogeneration Venture Limited Partnership*, 135 FERC ¶ 61,200 (2011). The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of this Settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding. The Commission retains the right to investigate the rates, terms, and conditions under the just and reasonable and not unduly discriminatory or preferential standard of section 206 of the Federal Power Act, 16 U.S.C. § 824e (2006).

3. Pursuant to the requirements of Order No. 714,¹ MCV is directed to make a compliance filing in eTariff format to reflect the Commission's action in this order.²
4. This letter order terminates Docket No. ER11-3035-000.
