Dear Mr. Fosbre, Ms. Foley, and Ms. Chevis:

1. On April 25, 2012, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) and the City
of Tacoma, Washington filed an Offer of Settlement, including a Settlement and Release

of Claims Agreement (Settlement), which would resolve all issues between them in the referenced proceeding.

2. Initial Comments on the Settlement were filed by PGE and Commission Trial Staff on May 15, 2012, and the Reply Comment period was waived. On May 17, 2012, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as uncontested.¹

3. The Commission finds that the Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and it is hereby approved.

4. This letter order terminates Docket No. EL01-10-079.
