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Dear Counsel:

1. On September 28, 2012, MPS Merchant Services, Inc. (f/k/a Aquila Energy Marketing Corporation (or Aquila Power Corporation)) and MPS Canada Corp. (f/k/a Aquila Canada Corp.) (collectively, MPS) and the City of Seattle, Washington (Seattle) filed an Offer of Settlement (Settlement), which resolves all outstanding issues between Seattle and MPS in the above-referenced proceeding.

2. Initial Comments on the Settlement were filed by Commission Trial Staff on October 18, 2012, and Reply Comments were not filed. The Settlement was certified to the Commission as uncontested on October 22, 2012.<sup>1</sup>

3. The Commission finds that the Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and it is hereby approved.

4. This letter order terminates Docket No. EL01-10-109.
