Dear Mr. Schwartz:

On July 25, 2012, you filed, in the above-referenced proceedings, an Offer of Settlement (Settlement) on behalf of Duquesne Light Company (Duquesne) and the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (MISO). On August 8, 2012, Commission Trial Staff filed comments that do not oppose the Settlement. No adverse or reply comments were filed. On September, 5, 2012, the Settlement Judge certified the uncontested Settlement to the Commission.

2. The Settlement addresses the exit fee Duquesne is obligated to pay MISO to withdraw from the Agreement of Transmission Facilities Owners to Organize MISO. The Settlement resolves all issues in dispute in these proceedings. The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of this settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in these proceedings.
