Ladies and Gentlemen:

1. On July 24, 2013, Seaway Crude Pipeline Company LLC (Seaway) filed FERC Tariff No. 2.5.0,¹ cancelling FERC Tariff No. 2.4.0, with an effective date of August 15, 2013. The tariff added Freeport, Texas as a new destination. No rate changes were proposed.

2. Seaway requests special permission for a waiver of the notice requirement under Section 6(3) of the Interstate Commerce Act to allow for FERC No. 2.5.0 to go into effect on twenty-one (21) days' notice. The shortened notice period is in response to a shipper request to move barrels to the new destination point by no later than August 15, 2013, in order to take advantage of a limited window of opportunity at a maritime loading docket at Freeport, Texas.

3. In the tariff, new language was added to clarify that "FERC No. 2.5.0 is subject to the outcome of the Docket No. IS12-226 cost of service proceeding and will remain subject to refund until that proceeding is concluded." No protests or interventions were filed in response to the subject tariff filing, or request for waiver of the 30-day notice requirement. Therefore, the Commission will grant the request for waiver of the notice requirement under Section 6(3) of the Interstate Commerce Act to allow FERC No. 2.5.0 to go into effect subject to refund and conditions.

Accordingly, pursuant to the authority contained in the Interstate Commerce Act, particularly section 15(7) thereof, the Commission accepts and suspends Seaway's FERC No. 2.5.0, and will allow it to become effective August 15, 2013, subject to refund, the outcome of the hearing procedures in Docket No. IS12-226, and to further order of the Commission.
