Dear Mr. Paradise, Ms. Holyoke, and Mr. Simon:

1. On October 9, 2013, you filed, on behalf of ISO New England Inc. (ISO-NE) and Bangor Hydro Electric Company (Bangor Hydro), an unexecuted Amended and Restated Large Generator Interconnection Agreement (Revised LGIA)¹ among ISO-NE; the transmission owner, Bangor Hydro; and two interconnection customers, Evergreen Wind Power II, LLC (Evergreen Wind) and Maine Gen Lead, LLC (Maine Gen), with a requested effective date of October 11, 2013.

2. You state that the Revised LGIA converts the currently-filed three-party LGIA² (among ISO-NE, Bangor Hydro, and Evergreen Wind) into a four-party LGIA (Maine Gen), in order to reflect Maine Gen's ownership of the generator lead line. You explain that the Revised LGIA is presently unexecuted because the Maine Public Utilities Commission (Maine Commission) must approve any agreement between Bangor Hydro and its affiliates, Maine Gen and Evergreen Wind, prior to its execution. You further state that Bangor Hydro will submit a request to the Maine Commission for an order approving the Revised LGIA.
3. Notice of the filing was published in the *Federal Register*, 78 Fed. Reg. 62,345 (2013), with interventions and protests due on or before October 30, 2013. None was filed.
4. The Revised LGIA is hereby accepted for filing, effective October 11, 2013,³ as requested, subject to Bangor Hydro submitting a compliance filing within 14 days of the Maine Commission's determination, describing the outcome of the proceeding and, as necessary, including an executed agreement.
