Dear Mr. Sampson:

1. On June 6, 2012, pursuant to section 205 of the Federal Power Act (FPA),¹ Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) filed an unexecuted Small Generator Interconnection Agreement (Agreement) with Acciona Solar Energy LLC² (Acciona) for the development of a solar photovoltaic generating facility, the Lakeview Solar One project (Project). On August 6, 2012, the Commission accepted the unexecuted Agreement for filing, suspended it for a nominal period to become effective August 9, 2012, subject to refund, and established hearing and settlement judge procedures.³
2. On October 31, 2013, PG&E and Acciona filed a joint motion to terminate the proceeding. PG&E states that, following the August 6 Order, it engaged in settlement discussions with Acciona, which resulted in an executed *pro forma* Small Generator Interconnection Agreement (New *Pro Forma* SGIA) between PG&E and Maricopa East Solar PV, LLC, Acciona's successor in interest for development of the Project. The motion states that the New *Pro Forma* SGIA was executed and became effective on October 16, 2013, and provides the terms and conditions for the interconnection of the

Project to PG&E's system. Therefore the unexecuted Agreement at issue in this proceeding has become moot. Thus, PG&E and Acciona request that the Commission grant the joint motion for termination of the proceeding in Docket No. ER12-1968-000. On November 8, 2013, the Chief Administrative Law Judge issued an order terminating the settlement judge procedures.⁴

3. We grant PG&E and Acciona's joint motion to terminate the proceeding in Docket No. ER12-1968-000.
