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Dear Counsel:

1. On August 27, 2012, you filed an offer of settlement (Settlement), in the above-referenced proceedings, on behalf of Shetek Wind Inc.; Jeffers South, LLC; Allco Renewable Energy Limited; EcoEnergy, LLC; Prairie Rose Wind, LLC; Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (MISO);¹ Renewable Energy Systems Americas, Inc.; High Country Energy, LLC; Great River Energy; and Xcel Energy Services Inc. on behalf of Northern States Power Company, a Minnesota corporation, and Northern States Power Company, a Wisconsin corporation. On September 17, 2012, Commission Trial Staff filed comments in support of the Settlement. No other comments were filed. On September 30, 2012, the Settlement Judge certified the Settlement to the Commission as an uncontested settlement.²
2. The Settlement addresses MISO's processing of certain generator interconnection applications and generator interconnection agreements based upon a "Net Zero" interconnection policy.³
3. The Settlement resolves all issues in dispute in these proceedings. The Settlement appears to be fair and reasonable and in the public interest, and is hereby approved. The Commission's approval of this settlement does not constitute approval of, or precedent regarding, any principle or issue in this proceeding.
