Dear Mr. Hagan:

1. On January 17, 2013, Occidental Chemical Corporation (Occidental) filed a petition for declaratory order and complaint against the Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc. (MISO)¹ with respect to MISO's proposed treatment of qualifying facilities (QF) in the Entergy Services, Inc. (Entergy) service territory upon Entergy's joining MISO. Since that time, effective December 19, 2013, Entergy joined MISO and MISO began providing transmission service on the Entergy transmission system under MISO's Open Access Transmission, Energy and Operating Reserve Markets Tariff (Tariff). Therefore, Occidental is requested to supplement the record in this proceeding with the following information:

(a) Whether Occidental has registered as a market participant in MISO and, if so, how Occidental has participated as a market participant; and

(b) Updates to Occidental's complaint to reflect experience regarding the treatment of its QF under MISO's Tariff, along with any supporting documents.

2. Please file your response with the Secretary of the Commission by April 7, 2014. Other parties may also respond to the request for information if they so choose, no later than twenty-one (21) days after Occidental's response. In addition, please provide a copy of your response to all parties on the service list in this proceeding.

3. This order is not subject to rehearing pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713. Any documents filed with the Commission for which confidentiality is sought may be filed under the terms of 18 C.F.R. § 388.112.
