ORDER VACATING SECTION 3 AUTHORIZATION AND REVOKING
PRESIDENTIAL PERMIT

(Issued November 21, 2014)

1. On June 18, 2009, the Commission issued a Natural Gas Act (NGA) section 3 authorization and a Presidential Permit to Oasis Pipeline, LP (Oasis) and Oasis Pipe Line Company Texas L.P. (Oasis Texas) for authorization to construct and operate natural gas export facilities at the international boundary between the United States and Mexico in El Paso County, Texas.¹ Ordering Paragraph (C) required Oasis and Oasis Texas to complete and place into service the authorized border crossing facilities within three years of the date of the order. In a letter order issued on June 13, 2012, the Division of Pipeline Certificates in the Office of Energy Projects extended until June 18, 2014, the deadline for constructing and placing the facilities into service.

2. Oasis and Oasis Texas have not commenced construction of the authorized facilities. As the extended deadline for the in-service date has expired and neither company requested an additional time extension, we are vacating the section 3 authorization and revoking the Presidential Permit to construct the proposed border crossing facilities.
