ORDER VACATING CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZATIONS

(Issued March 4, 2015)

1. On June 13, 2002, the Commission authorized Copiah Storage, LLC (Copiah) pursuant to section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act (NGA)¹ to construct, own, operate, and maintain natural gas storage facilities in Copiah County, Mississippi.² In the same order, the Commission also issued Copiah a blanket transportation certificate under Subpart G of Part 284 of the regulations³ and a blanket construction certificate under subpart F of Part 157 of the regulations.⁴ Copiah has been granted several extensions of the time to complete construction and place the authorized storage facilities in service. The current extension of time ends March 31, 2015.⁵

2. On February 9, 2015, Copiah filed a request to vacate its certificate authorizations, stating that demand for the project storage capacity has not materialized and is not expected to do so for the foreseeable future. Since Copiah does not intend to construct

and operate the storage facilities, we will vacate its Part 157, Subpart A certificate authorizing the project, its Part 157, Subpart F blanket construction certificate, and its Part 284, Subpart G blanket transportation certificate.

The Commission orders:

Copiah's certificate authorizations are vacated.
