ORDER ACCEPTING AND SUSPENDING TARIFF RECORD SUBJECT
TO REFUND AND CONDITIONS

(Issued May 8, 2015)

1. On April 10, 2015, Calnev Pipe Line, LLC (Calnev) filed a joint tariff¹ to implement new joint rates with its affiliate SFPP, L.P. (SFPP) to be effective May 11, 2015. On April 6, 2015, SFPP had earlier filed revised tariff records to implement its April 6, 2015 compliance filing in Docket No. IS08-390-000, et al. by modifying its current West Line rates,² effective May 11, 2015. The proposed Calnev joint tariff combines the rates for the SFPP West Line from Watson and East Hynes in California to destinations on Calnev in Clark County, Nevada. The Commission accepts and suspends the proposed tariff record, to be effective May 11, 2015, subject to refund and a further Commission order in this docket pending the outcome of the proceedings in Docket Nos. IS08-390-000, et al., IS11-444-000, et al., OR14-35-000, et al., and OR14-36-000, et al.
2. On April 27, 2015, Tesoro Refining & Marketing Company LLC (Tesoro) filed a protest. Tesoro states that the Commission should summarily reject the joint rate filed in this docket due to the SFPP portion of the joint rate. As a basis for this claim, Tesoro restates certain objections that it made in its protest to SFPP's April 6 filing in Docket

No. IS08-390-000, et al. Tesoro also notes that there are other pending matters challenging SFPP's West Line rates.

3. On May 4, 2015, Calnev and SFPP filed a joint answer. In the answer, they emphasize that Tesoro's only objection to the joint tariff is the allegation that the joint tariff incorporates "unlawful rate increases" related to SFPP's April 6 compliance filing in Docket No. IS08-390-000, et al. They assert that the Commission should accept the joint tariff, subject to refund, pending the final outcome in the ongoing proceedings involving SFPP's West Line rates, including Docket No. IS08-390-000, et al.

4. The Commission accepts and suspends the proposed tariff record, effective May 11, 2015, subject to refund and a further Commission order in this docket pending the resolution of the proceedings in Docket Nos. IS08-390-000, et al., IS11-444-000, et al., OR14-35-000, et al., and OR14-36-000, et al. It is not necessary to reject the joint tariff filing as asserted by Tesoro. The Commission will address protests and comments to SFPP's April 6 compliance filing in a subsequent order in Docket No. IS08-390-000, et al.

The Commission orders:

The tariff record listed in footnote one is accepted and suspended, effective May 11, 2015, subject to refund and a further Commission order in this docket pending the outcome of the proceedings in Docket Nos. IS08-390-000, et al., IS11-444-000, et al., OR14-35-000, et al., and OR14-36-000, et al.
