Dear Mr. Whiteford:

1. On May 28, 2015, Destin Pipeline Company, L.L.C. (Destin) filed revised tariff records<sup>1</sup> to reflect changes to its Fuel Retention Percentage (FRP). Destin requests limited waiver of section 24 of the General Terms and Conditions (GT&C) of its tariff, so that it may place the FRP rate in effect June 1, 2015. Destin proposes to decrease the FRP from 0.3 percent to 0.05 percent. Destin's filing also includes other minor adjustments to its tariff to reflect the relocation of its offices. As discussed below, we grant Destin's request for limited waiver of its tariff and accept the tariff records listed in the Appendix to be effective June 1, 2015, as requested.

2. Section 24 of the GT&C requires Destin to adjust its FRP after each 12-month period ending August 31, but allows an exception if the re-determined FRP varies by less than 0.1 percent from the FRP in effect at the time. Destin seeks to reduce the FRP to 0.05 percent from 0.3 percent, which has been in place since 2012.<sup>2</sup> Destin seeks waiver of section 24 in order to make the lower FRP percentage effective June 1, 2015. Destin states that the FRP is reduced due to a marked decrease in fuel usage at the Pascagoula gas processing plant and that implementing the new rate early will benefit its shippers.

3. Public notice of the filing was issued on May 29, 2015. Interventions and protests were due as provided in section 154.210 of the Commission's regulations (18 C.F.R. § 154.210 (2014)). Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2014)), all timely filed motions to intervene and any unopposed motion to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. Granting late intervention at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No protests or adverse comments were filed.

4. Based upon its review of the filing, the Commission accepts the tariff records listed in the Appendix, to be effective June 1, 2015. The Commission finds good cause to grant limited waiver of section 24 of Destin's GT&C and the Commission's notice requirements as a result of the lower FRP rate and related benefit to consumers.
