Dear Ms. Stanford:

On June 22, 2015, you filed on behalf of L'Anse Warden Electric Company (L'Anse Warden) a notice of cancellation requesting that the Commission cancel its market-based rate tariff. You state that L'Anse Warden is exempt from Sections 205 and 206 of the Federal Power Act and no longer requires its market-based rate authority.

Your filing was noticed on June 23, 2015, with comments, protests or interventions due on or before July 13, 2015. None was filed.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittal filed in the referenced docket is accepted for filing, effective June 23, 2015, as requested.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against the applicant.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
