Dear Ms. Gianvecchio:

On June 16, 2015, you filed on behalf of Duquesne Keystone LLC (Duquesne Keystone) and Duquesne Conemaugh LLC (Duquesne Conemaugh) notices of cancellation requesting that the Commission cancel their market-based rate tariffs. You also request that the Commission cancel Duquesne Keystone's and Duquesne Conemaugh's certificates of concurrence to the reactive power tariffs filed by Chief Keystone Power, LLC and Chief Conemaugh Power, LLC, respectively. You state that Duquesne Keystone and Duquesne Conemaugh no longer have a need for their market-based rate or reactive power tariffs.

Your filings were noticed on June 17, 2015, with comments, protests or interventions due on or before July 7, 2015. None was filed.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, your submittals filed in the referenced dockets are accepted for filing, effective June 30, 2015, as requested.

This action does not constitute approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service provided for in the filed documents; nor shall such action be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation affecting or relating to such service or rate; and such acceptance is

without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against any of the applicants.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713.
