Dear Mr. Birgisson:

On January 13, 2015, as amended on May 29, 2015, you filed on behalf of Sellers a notice of change in status stating that BAL Investment & Advisory, Inc. and BNY Partnership Funding LLC acquired non-controlling, Class B membership interests in Sellers.¹ You state that this acquisition does not affect the conditions the Commission relied upon when granting Sellers market-based rate authority.

Your filings were noticed on January 14, 2015 and May 29, 2015, with comments, protests or interventions due on or before February 3, 2015 and June 19, 2015, respectively. None was filed.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - West, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307, and based on your representations, the notice of change in status is accepted for filing.
