Dear Mr. Gergen:

On March 9, 2015, you filed on behalf of Sellers a notice of change in status stating that FREIF Redwood Holdings LLC acquired 100 percent of the indirect membership interests in Redwood III, LLC, the upstream owner of Badger Creek Limited, Double C Generation Limited Partnership, High Sierra Limited, and Kern Front Limited. You state that this acquisition does not affect the conditions the Commission relied upon when granting Sellers market-based rate authority. Based on your representations, your submittal satisfies the Commission's requirements for market-based rate authority regarding vertical market power.

Your filing was noticed on March 10, 2015, with comments, protests or interventions due on or before March 30, 2015. None was filed.
