I grant Cameron LNG, LLC's (Cameron LNG) June 24, 2015 request for notice to proceed with construction activities for structural steel, foundations, and pilings for Trains 1 and 2 at the Cameron Liquefaction Project in Cameron and Calcasieu Parishes, Louisiana; as described in Attachments 4, 5, and 6 in the June 24th submittal.

In considering this approval, we have reviewed Cameron LNG's filings and find them to be consistent with Environmental Condition 15b of the Commission's June 19, 2014 *Order Granting Authorization Under Section 3 of the Natural Gas Act and Issuing Certificates* (Order) for these items in the above-referenced docket.

I remind you that Cameron LNG must comply with all applicable terms and conditions of the Order and procedures stipulated in your filings.

Please note that this approval does not grant Cameron LNG the authority to construct in the portion of the area that is currently being surcharged or commence construction of additional project facilities at the LNG terminal.
